Hi everyone! I enjoy spending my days flying around the Museum, looking for flowers to pollinate and meeting new friends. Follow the clues below to find me in my new favorite spots at BADM.

Clue

My wings are colorful, but I am small and sometimes hard to spot. Look for me and some other hard to spot creatures—they're on the ground and made out of tiny pieces of stone and tile.

Mission Blue Butterflies are very small—about the size of a quarter. My size is closer to the size of a child's hand. **Measure** some of the animals you see in the mosaic. How many are larger than your hand? How many are smaller?

Clue

I live in grassy areas and perch on flowers, but when I'm at BADM, sometimes I like to hide in a place that is cool and dark. See if you can find my hiding place!

Butterflies often hide in protected areas when the weather is damp or rainy. Look around BADM—what other areas do you **predict** I might hide in next?

Clue

I'm hungry! I usually eat nectar and my larvae babies eat leaves. But today, I'd like to cook something in the kitchen! You'll find me near a very muddy stove.

Look around the museum for places I could find nectar and leaves. See if you can **observe** other food sources for my family.


Clue
